RE: Spill Closure Approval [CVID #22153]

To Whom It May Concern:

The Enforcement Program (ENF) of the Montana Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) received a report that approximately 100 gallons of diesel fuel spilled to the environment due to a truck accident on Interstate 90 Eastbound, mile marker 315.8 in Gallatin County, Montana. The incident occurred on March 26, 2020.

On June 24, 2020, a report was received from Jeb Pedrazzi with Olympus Technical Services that outlined the cleanup activities. Approximately 34.7 tons of diesel fuel-impacted soils were removed. The impacted soil was transported to Logan Landfill in Gallatin County, Montana, for disposal. The excavation was backfilled with MDT road mix, graded, seeded, and an erosion blanket was installed to reduce erosion due to the steep slope at the spill site. Analytical results for the samples taken indicate all impacted soils were adequately removed from the site.
